CHILD CARE FOUNDATIONAL TRAINING DATA

Funding for the Free Child Care Foundational Training courses, which began in June of 2022, recently came to a close. We have a lot of exciting data to share with you about these courses!

Thank you to the Department of Children and Families for providing funding on these courses!

9,184

Over 9,000 verified attendees took advantage of the free CCFTs over the past year! As word spread, these courses became more popular as the last two months both saw over 1,000 verified attendees. Every month after June of 2022 had over 500 verified attendees complete these courses!

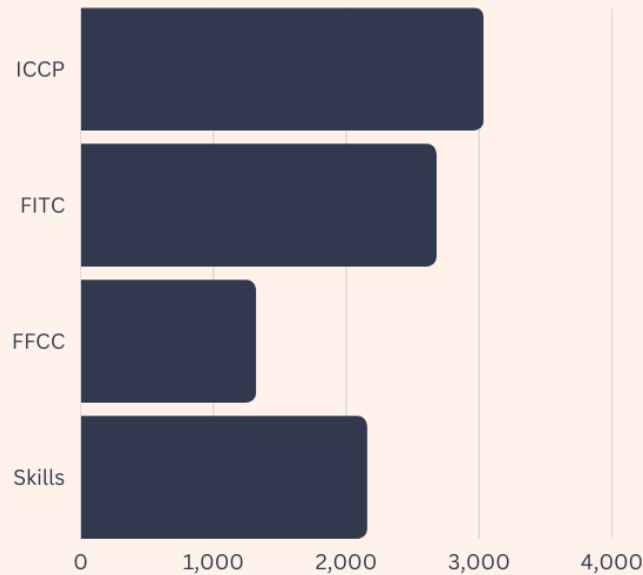
There were a total of 369 CCFT events over the duration of the grant! A total of 17 Child Care Resource & Referral Agencies and Training Sponsor Organizations completed events during that time.
