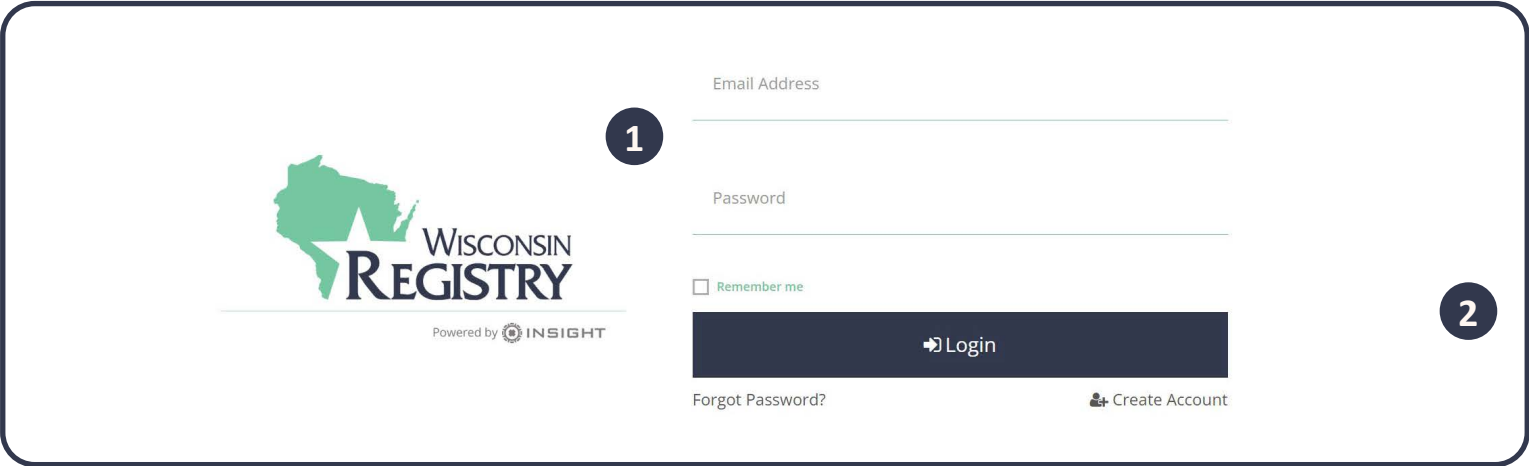
If more than one child care foundational training has been completed, up to two certificates will be displayed per page. This report is accessible at any time and does not require a current Registry membership.

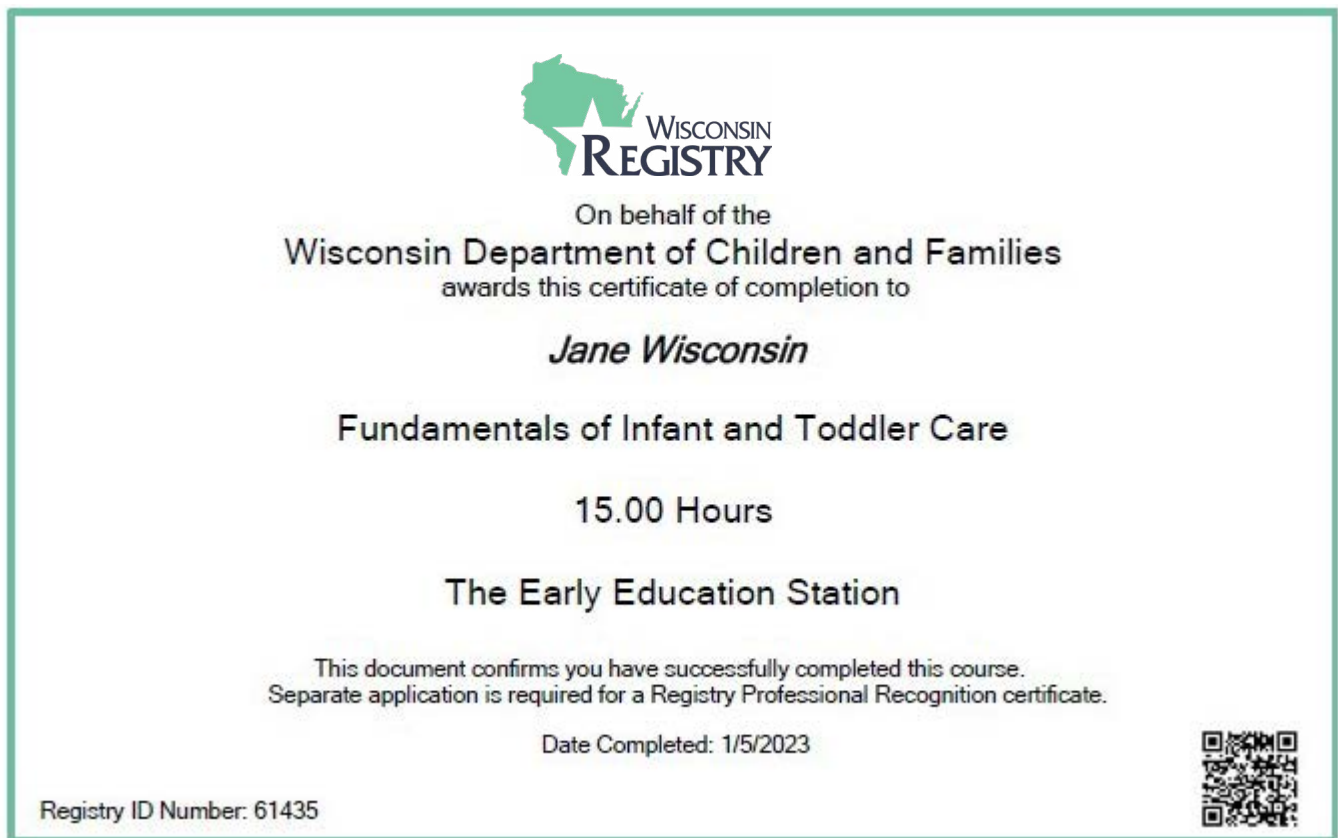
