A Wisconsin Registry certificate is required for all teachers, directors and administrators in licensed child care programs. A Wisconsin Registry Certificate and Learning Record acknowledge and highlight the training, experience and professionalism that are vital to quality early care and education, honoring each recipient's unique training and background.

### **Benefits of a Registry Membership**

#### **Wisconsin Registry Certificate**

This document lists important information including your Career Level, all regulated care positions preliminarily qualified for, years of experience, and more. Registry certificates are accepted by Wisconsin state licensing specialists.

#### **Eligibility**

A Wisconsin Registry membership is required to be eligible to commission for a Registry Credential or to become an approved Trainer or Technical Assistance Professional.

# Professional Development and Employment Opportunities

A Wisconsin Registry profile profile provides a summary of a member's education and training related to the field of early care and education. Current members can login to print a variety of reports to add to any resume or use for professional development planning.

# Participation in Other Programs

Membership with the Wisconsin Registry allows individuals and organizations to participate in other programs such as YoungStar, T.E.A.C.H. and REWARD.

#### **Document Organization**

The Wisconsin Registry stores a member's education and training information in case documents are lost or needed for licensing purposes. A member account includes the upload of official transcripts and a full list of verified education and related training.

#### Receive a Registry elD

A Registry eID helps ensure that you receive immediate verification for the training events you attend. The eID lists your name, Registry ID number, and a QR code that allows trainers to quickly scan your card and accurately take attendance.
