Best Practices: Acceptable Documentation

The Wisconsin Registry receives and evaluates documentation from members to verify trainings and educational achievements. Verified achievements impact your Registry Career Level and preliminary position qualifications.

Please note, when submitting documentation (official transcripts, training certificates, CPR cards, or high school documentation) for review and verification, you must first apply for or renew your Registry membership. Submitting your initial application or renewing your membership gives the Wisconsin Registry team permission to access your profile and properly process any changes.
