Trainer Hours of Experience



Trainer experience refers to hours of experience spent teaching a course or workshop to adults. Below is a table you may use to easily document your training experience hours. You need to include the title of the training, the final date it occurred, and the number of hours for that training. Trainer experience is required to qualify for Tier, Specialist 2, and Specialist 3 Trainers. A minimum of 20 Trainer hours of experience is required for a Tier 1 Trainer. A minimum of 40 Trainer hours of experience is required for a Tier 2, Tier 3, Specialist 2 and Specialist 3 Trainer. Your training hours do not have to be hours from the last few years in the early childhood field, these can also be hours from years previous.

Trainer Experience hours are different than Technical Assistance Professional hours. There is a separate resource document to assist in recording Technical Assistance Professional hours.
