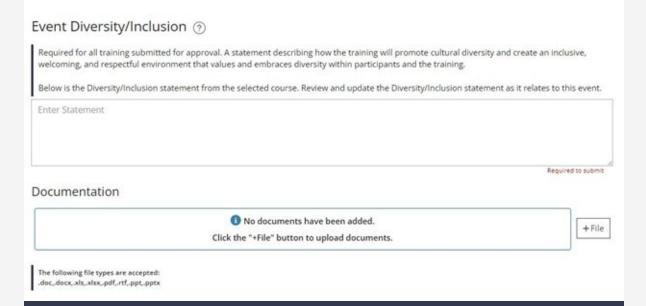


EVENT D&I STATEMENT

REMINDERS FOR TRAINERS

A couple of reminders for Trainers using the PDASystem!

Always renew your Wisconsin Registry membership when updating your Trainer Level.

 If you need to submit new documentation for your Trainer Profile, please be sure to submit the documentation along with a membership renewal. This is especially important if you are looking to be approved for a different Trainer Level. As a reminder, membership renewal is FREE! As long as your membership hasn't expired, you will not lose access to any of the PDASystem while your renewal application is being processed.

Rosters close 45 days after the last date of the event.

After a Tiered training event is facilitated, the Trainer or Training Sponsor
must enter the attendance roster within 45 days of the last day of the
training event. Entering an attendance roster is not required for a Registered
training but is highly recommended. By entering an attendance roster,
attendees receive instant credit on their Registry profile for completing the
training.
